# XXXVII Annual Conference Indian Pharmacological Society

## General Information

The Indian Pharmacological Society (IPS) is the foremost professional body representing Indian pharmacologists. Membership of IPS currently stands in excess of 2000 and includes pharmacologists, clinical pharmacologists, toxicologists, veterinarians, pharmaceutical scientists, pharmacists, drug control experts and academicians and researchers from other branches of medicine. A large section of the membership comprises young pharmacologists undergoing postgraduate training under various universities. The Society is scheduled to host its 37th Annual Conference between January 14-16, 2005 at Science City, Kolkata. This is to be attended by researchers, academicians and students from all over India and also abroad. The expected number of delegates is 600-700.

The West Bengal branch of IPS is hosting this XXXVII Annual Conference.

The inaugural function is being scheduled at 17:00 hours on Jan 14, 2005.

A one-day Pre-conference Workshop on Analytical Techniques in Pharmacology is being scheduled for January 13, 2005. This is targeted at postgraduate students of pharmacology and allied disciplines. A maximum of 50 participants can be accommodated in the workshop on first come - first served basis. The Workshop is open only to participants who also attend the Main Conference.

### The venue

Kolkata (erstwhile Calcutta) requires no introduction. It is one of the largest metropolitan cities of India well connected by land, rail and air-routes to other cities and towns. The Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose international airport (popularly called Dum Dum airport) serves the city and the whole of eastern and north-eastern India. The railheads are at Howrah and Sealdah terminal stations. Most long-distance buses terminate at the Esplanade bus terminus.

Traveling within the city is no problem with plenty of taxis, trams, government and private buses and auto-rickshaws plying different routes. The underground metro railway takes a north-south route through the city. The conference organizers will arrange for transport between the sites of accommodation, conference, inaugural function and banquet venues.

Kolkata's climate in mid-January is quite pleasant in the daytime and chilly at night. Rains are unusual. In fact mid-December to mid-February is the picnic season in Kolkata. Light to moderate woolen clothing is recommended. The organizers will arrange for meals during the conference.

The scientific sessions of the conference will be held at Science City, East Topsia Road, Kolkata 700 046, perhaps the most popular conference venue in Kolkata at present. It is located on the Eastern Metropolitan Bypass with the ITC Sonar Bangla hotel just opposite to it. Besides being a conference venue, Science City is an amusement park aiming to stimulate the scientific spirit in its visitors, specially the young ones. Therefore, bring your family along and take a break from the monotony of daily life in the invigorating chill of Kolkata winter.

The Pre-Conference workshop is planned to be organized at the Conference Secretariat itself.

### The conference secretariat

This is at the Department of Pharmacology, Institute of Postgraduate Medical Education & Research (IPGME&R), Kolkata. This institute with its accompanying hospital, the Seth Sukhlal Karnani Memorial (SSKM) Hospital, popularly called PG Hospital, is the largest postgraduate

medical institute complex in West Bengal. Besides medical, it offers nursing, physiotherapy and various other paramedical courses. The Pharmacology Department is located on the first floor of the Dr. B. C. Roy Postgraduate Institute of Basic Medical Sciences building.

IPGME&R is located in the cultural heart of the city with the famed Victoria Memorial, Rabindra Sadan theater, the Nandan movie and cultural complex and the Calcutta Race Course all at stone's throw.

### **Registration**

Details of registration and the necessary forms are provided in this brochure. Please read the details carefully before filling in the forms. This will save a lot of trouble later on. Incomplete, illegible or otherwise inappropriate forms are liable to be rejected.

Please calculate and total up the various charges carefully before filling in the payment details. Full advance payment is required. Payment can be accepted from delegates only by Demand Draft.

### **Scientific deliberations and paper submission**

The Organizing Committee will leave no stone unturned to provide you with a rich academic fare during the conference. All prestigious IPS orations and award sessions would be there in addition to authoritative invited lectures, plenaries and symposia. The S. B. Pandey Memorial Oration, S. C. Lahiri Memorial Oration and CDRI Oration are set to debut in this conference. We encourage delegates to submit their best papers at the conference that will also see overseas visitors. While utmost efforts would be made to accommodate oral presentations, this would be at the discretion of the Scientific Committee. As is inevitable with large conferences, a proportion of the papers can only be accommodated as poster presentations. Early birds stand a better chance of getting accommodated in the oral paper sessions.

Please check and fulfill all the requirements for abstract submission to avoid disappointment. For most prize sessions, the full text paper needs to be submitted well in advance.

Acceptance of papers cannot be guaranteed even if deadlines are met.

### **Sight-seeing**

Kolkata offers a lot of attraction to tourists. Various city tours and overnight sightseeing tours are possible. Science city in itself can easily take up a day to explore and enjoy.

Going by the experience of past IPS conferences, the organizers will not arrange for tours themselves. However, counters of travel agents would be available at the conference venue and the delegates may avail of the services they provide. However, it is our earnest request to all delegates to be present at the Inaugural Function and also at the paper sessions to encourage young scientists and researchers who will be presenting their work.

## Accommodation Details

All accommodation requests must be communicated latest by October 15, 2004, along with remittance of full advance amount for the entire period of stay at the minimum rate applicable to the type of accommodation given as first choice. The advance amount will be deposited at the respective hotel and will be adjusted against the final settlement of the delegate's hotel bill at checkout time.

Kindly note that usual check-in and check-out time in hotels / guest houses is 12 Noon. It may be difficult to arrange accommodation for more than 1 day prior to the Main Conference / Pre-conference Workshop to more than 1 day after the conference.

Accommodation cannot be guaranteed if requests are received after the due date. Confirmed accommodation arrangements will be made only on receiving the duly filled in Accommodation Request Form (Form B) and the full advance payment amount by Demand Draft. Utmost effort would be made to accommodate according to the first or second choice indicated in this form, on a twin sharing basis. However, this cannot be guaranteed. Only limited accommodation is available in guest houses and dormitories and will be allotted on a 'first come - first served' basis. If allotted to the next higher category, the difference in charges may have to be borne by the delegate. If allotted to a lower category, a claim is to be submitted and refund will be made after the conference.

### Note regarding travel arrangements

## Abstract Preparation and Presentation Details

The Scientific Committee for the XXXVII Annual Conference of the Indian Pharmacological Society invites delegates desirous of presenting papers to submit abstract as per following guidelines.

- The abstract should be structured as per the present format prescribed by the Indian Journal of Pharmacology (IJP). It should be complete with the subheadings - TITLE, AUTHORS, ADDRESS, OBJECTIVES, METHODS, RESULTS and CONCLUSIONS. References are not needed for abstracts. Incomplete abstracts or those not appropriately structured will be rejected.
- The TITLE should be written in capitals.
- Name of authors should start with surname, followed by initials of first and middle name. List no more than 6 authors. Underline the name of presenting author.
- The main body of the abstract should not exceed 200 to 250 words and must be prepared in the IJP format with clearly outlined OBJECTIVES, METHODS, RESULTS and CONCLUSIONS.
- Type in single space within the rectangle provided in the Abstract Form (Form C). Use high quality black inkjet or laser printing or electronic typing only. Handwritten abstracts cannot be accepted.
- SEND THREE COPIES OF THE ABSTRACT – one original and two photocopies. ALSO SEND THE ABSTRACT BY E-MAIL.

Abstracts will be considered only when accompanied by registration fee. Acceptance of an abstract is solely at the discretion of the Scientific Committee.

Authors are required to mention the preferred Presentation Code (i.e. oral or poster) and the Subject Code (the one best suited from the list given below) on Form C. The code for prize session must be mentioned if applicable. Each participant is allowed to present only one paper / poster. Only a limited number of papers can be accepted for oral presentation.

For oral presentations, you are requested to prepare good quality 35 mm slides / transparencies or Microsoft PowerPoint slides. 35 mm Slide and Multimedia Projectors will be available. Overhead Projectors will also be available. However, overhead transparency projection, even if of high quality, may not be suitable for a large gathering. The presenting author must get his / her presentation previewed and ready well in time and will be given 8 minutes for presentation and 2 minutes for discussion.

For poster presentations, a space of 1 meter x 1 meter will be made available to each participant. Use of color illustration is encouraged in posters. Please prepare your posters in such a way that

the letters / illustrations are readable from distance of 10 meters. The presenting author **MUST** be present during the entire duration of the allotted poster session.

We seek your utmost co-operation in achieving a high degree of academic standard in the presentation of papers in scientific sessions and subsequent publication of the abstracts in the Indian Journal of Pharmacology.

Information about IPS prizes and participation in Prize Sessions

#### **ACHARI PRIZE**

This prize is awarded to the member of IPS who presents the best paper during the Achari prize session of the conference in which a maximum of 10 entries will be permitted.

*Eligibility* – The presenting author must be a valid IPS member and a registered delegate for the conference. He / She should be below 35 years of age. (Certificate of age **MUST** be submitted). The work must have been conducted in an Indian laboratory.

#### **U.K. SETH PRIZE**

This is for the best paper presented in a special session on clinical pharmacology.

*Eligibility* – There is no age restriction. Valid IPS member duly registered for the conference are eligible. The work must have been carried out in an Indian institution.

#### **O. D. GULATI PRIZE**

This is awarded for the best paper on Cardiovascular / Autacoid / Autonomic Pharmacology.

*Eligibility* – As for the Achari Prize. However, contestants upto 40 years of age can compete.

#### **GUFIC PRIZE**

This is for the best paper on indigenous drugs presented during the conference. There may be no special session for this purpose.

*Eligibility* – As for the U. K. Seth Prize.

#### **P.C. DANDIYA PRIZE**

This prize is for the best poster presentation in the conference.

*Eligibility* – As for the U. K. Seth Prize.

#### **Conditions for submission of entries for Prize sessions:**

- Four copies of the full paper conforming to the present format of Indian Journal of Pharmacology must be submitted by 15.09.2004 to the Organizing Secretary.
- Papers dealing exclusively with clinical pharmacology will not be considered for the Achari Prize.
- Author / co-author(s) must not be the author / co-author(s) of other papers in the session. However, there is no restriction on number of entries from a particular department or laboratory.
- Contestant should be the first author of the paper and consent of co-author(s) to present the paper in an IPS Prize session should be submitted.

- The above do not apply for the P. C. Dandiya prize which is awarded on the basis of the best poster actually displayed at the conference.
- Method of conduct and judgement: Preliminary scrutiny and assessment of the entries for various prizes will be done by the Scientific Committee. The paper will be adjudged objectively at the conference by the panel of judges on the basis of originality, quality of work, interpretation of data and presentation.
- The prizes will be awarded at the annual general body meeting. No prize will be awarded if the number of entries in any particular prize sessions is less than five.
- Prize winning papers / presentations will become the intellectual property of IPS.
